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

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is well underway with the reconstruction of WIS 100 (S. 108th Street), from College Avenue to Edgerton Avenue.

Listed below are ongoing construction activities over the next few weeks:

Storm Sewer Installation:

- WIS 100 trunkline from Edgerton to Copeland avenues.
- WIS 100 trunkline from Whitnall Park Drive to College Avenue.
- Complete Stage 2 storm sewer on Edgerton Avenue.

Grading Operations:

- WIS 100 concrete pavement removal from Parnell to Forest Home avenues.
- WIS 100 placement of aggregate base material from Whitnall Park Road to the south project limits, and along side roads.
- Grange Avenue north side pavement removal (east/west of WIS 100).
- Janesville Road north side concrete pavement removal (east/west of WIS 100).
- Forest Home Avenue north side concrete pavement removal (east/west of WIS 100).

Box Culvert (south of Forest Home Avenue):

- Excavation of north and east sides of culvert.
- Reconstruction of north wall for storm sewer connection.

North side of Edgerton Avenue through I-43 Ramps:

- Installation of electrical including conduit, pole bases, and pull boxes.
- Installation of curb and gutter and driveway aprons on Edgerton Avenue.
- Finish grading and aggregate placement.
- Asphalt paving operations.
- Installation of sidewalk.

Traffic update:

- Roadways are in the Stage 2 configuration and will remain in effect until fall 2018. There will be traffic pattern changes from time to time throughout this stage.
- Flagging operations will be ongoing as needed for trucking operations at the various project work areas.
- The contractor will take periodic lane and I-43 ramp closures to construct the ramps entrances, refresh pavement markings, and replace marker posts.
